

## Rifle

- We offer a 20-yard indoor range, limited to .22 rimfire, which we use from October until April.
- A 185-yard outdoor range, which we use from May until September.
- The public is welcome on the 3rd and 4th Tuesday of the month, from 7:00 p.m. to dusk or 9:00 p.m., whichever is sooner; the indoor range for .22 rimfire and the outdoor range for centerfire and black powder.
- The first Sunday of the month, starting at 3:00 p.m., we hold an SKS shoot open to all service rifles.
